**General Matters:** 

#### Update on Northern District Council by Alan Gardiner -

Alan indicated he attended a recent council meeting regarding the Gordon Golf Course – he recommended the school/P&C should take the opportunity to make a submission regarding considerations for the school in any proposals eg making allowance for future school expansion, possible turning circle at the end of Fitzroy to allow a 2<sup>nd</sup> drop off zone and ease dangerous congestion.

Nina indicated a Grants and Submissions workshop held by Council Friday 29<sup>th</sup> would be good for relevant committee members to attend.

Last Monday's Regional Meeting – general issue regarding capacity of schools in the area, also Ryde is facing problems due to all the apartments going up around Macquarie Centre. Some parents raised concerns about privacy and data mining with students using google doc apps.

Federation Level – Alan raised concerns that 2 categories of graduate teachers are resulting from permanent teachers receiving mentoring and workplace introduction whereas casual teachers are missing out – and both are teaching our students.

Insurance is due end July. Negotiating with insurance company. Noted that ideally events notification should be given to insurance company although we are still covered if we don't notify and an incident occurs.

Proposal to Local Council to seek funds for the footpath at the front of the School Dimity McCredie spoke to council regarding front and rear footpath. Greg from council is getting design work done with view to it being implemented next financial year (possibly term 3 or 4)
