 - Killara Kids Report KK –. Katie. Vacation care program out last week. Currently looking at capping numbers at 50 per day. Some 3rd parties on site for the KK program. Contactless pick up and drop offs. Educators controlling at the gate. Pressure on staff. Lot more responsibility on the staff re lost property. Progressive afternoon tea implemented from Canteen. Training and Plans for development an support program inclusion and support policy being worked on. Currently focus on behaviours, but will be broadened to cultural and family etc. Final day this Friday for Katie before mat leave. - Principal Report PF as per written report. Some restriction lifted such as assemblies and PSSA sport next term and extra curricular activities Nearly business as usual next term. Still an element of social distancing with choir etc and re adults the same. Starting a new planning cycle moving into 2021, re vision for the school, future focus and wellbeing for the school, 2nd half of the year reviewing and refining those to align with our communicates needs. Whole school education week challenge, only the principal will now it. Release to classes by zoom, science project based learning. Parents can enter the zoom. Film Festival, diversity theme, family short films. Stewart appointed as General Assistant after an interview process. Matt assisted Pip with the interview and process. Changes re next term. Increased the support for personalised learning, English as a 2nd language (EALP program), small targeted groups for literacy and numeracy. Enrolments, nearly hitting benchmark for an additional class, next Term we will go up a class, so gain a teacher. Extra teacher t0 support Year 5 as large classes. Week 3 parent teacher interviews by Zoom. Booking info will come out in week 1. Building works starting next week, should take about a term. Also meeting about tender for further building, put together off site and then delivered hopefully January 2021. Like a large demountable and will go along the fenceline near the shed near the golf course. KK demountable to go.
